



# MONSTER MAKERS LATEX MASK PAINT

**Description:** A concentrated, pre-mixed paint medium developed for use on latex rubber masks and props. Features excellent coverage, super flexibility, dries quickly and adheres well to the mask surface. These specially formulated elastic paints have a unique, stretchy quality that allows them to bond to the latex rubber and flex without cracking or peeling.

## PRODUCT FEATURES

Colors can be intermixed to create custom colors. Can be used on a variety of slush latex, casting latex, molding latex and Mask Latex formulations but works especially well on our [RD-407 Mask Latex](#). Can also be used on urethane foam and Foam Latex as well. Colors can be intermixed to create an endless variety of shade possibilities. Recommended for use with external mix airbrushes such as the Paasche H or the Badger 350. Can also be applied with a brush or stippled with a sponge.

## INSTRUCTIONS

**Instructions for Use:** Mask Paint is a highly pigmented elastomer designed for maximum coverage and adhesion on latex masks and props. The individual paint colors may be intermixed to create a full range of custom colors. Some separation may occur during shipping or shelf time, so always shake well prior to use. Mask Paint can be applied several ways by hand, such as with a brush or stippling layers with a sponge. The most effective way to apply the paint is with an airbrush. It is highly recommended to use an “external mix” airbrush such as the **Paasche H** or **Badger 350** for paint application. These airbrushes mix the air and paint at the tip, outside the body of the brush, making for easier cleaning and maintenance. This is advantageous because the Mask Paint is a rather thick medium, making it difficult to maintain consistent flow in an internal mix brush. It is suggested to spray the paint at **60-80 psi** for

base-coating and **40-60 psi** for detailing. Mask Paint can thicken over time, so it may be necessary to thin it down some. Water can be used as a thinning agent, but be cautious not to use too much water as it may become water and possibly lose its elastic and adhesive properties. A few drops per ounce should be sufficient, and the paint may occasionally settle and need straining. To clean the paint from the brush, simply spray clean water through it, or simply pull dried paint out of spray cups. This is particularly important between color changes.

**Please Note:** The Mask Paint dries rather quickly and between ½ and a full shade darker than it appears in the bottle. Although the paint is relatively non-toxic, *always wear a dust mask or respirator with this or any airbrushed medium.*
